We can all help by donating extra supplies that we might have on hand. Some suggested supplies needed are as follows:

- Kleenex, toilet paper & paper towels
- Cold & flu medications
- Advil/Tylenol
- Hand sanitizer
- Cotton balls & isopropyl alcohol
- Lysol Spray, bleach & Clorox wipes
- Gloves
- Bandanas
- AA batteries
- Paper plates, cups & silverware
- Bottled water & Gatorade
- Non-perishable Dry and canned foods

Having access to these items will allow them the right to protect themselves, to keep their distance from crowds and slow the spread of this disease.
